Meeting Summary

On August 11 the FERC issued its Environmental Information Request (EIR) for Mountain Valley's draft Resource Reports (RR) 1 to 12. The USFS filed additional comments on August 18. USFS representatives will be coming to the FERC office in Washington DC later this month to discuss the project with staff.

Mountain Valley representatives will attend a meeting with staff at the FERC office in Washington DC in early September to discuss responses to the EIR. EPA staff may also attend. While these agency meetings are considered NEPA working paper meetings, not open to the public, notes from the meetings will be placed in the public file (eLibrary) for this docket.

Mountain Valley continues to conduct environmental field surveys where access is available. Consultants to the company completed bat mist net surveys for the season. Mussel surveys are ongoing. Mountain Valley filed several cultural resources survey reports last week.

The next conference call will on September 1, 2015.
