FERC staff drafted tribal consultation letters for management review.

FERC staff drafted an environmental information request for Mountain Valley. This is also under review by management.

Mountain Valley reported that field surveys for listed species, wetlands, streams, and cultural resources are progressing.

The FERC clarified that at this point, assessment of “cultural attachment” will apply only to U.S. Forest Service lands. Research is continuing into that topic.

The next coordination call will be held on August 4, 2015.
