Meeting Summary

Earlier this month, Mountain Valley re-trained all of their land agents and environmental crews on proper protocols to avoid trespass and other issues. Environmental surveys continue, including 100 miles of mist netting for bats. Mountain Valley is currently compiling responses to scoping comments filed to the FERC's docket.

The FERC staff is continuing to review public scoping comments and Mountain Valley's draft resource reports (RRs). The FERC requested that cooperating agencies email Paul Friedman with comments on the draft RRs before the end of this month. Cardno would then generate a draft Environmental Information Request (for FERC staff review) to be sent to Mountain Valley next month.

The FERC and the FS had a discussion about "cultural attachment." The FS will provide FERC staff with data that defines cultural attachment. As requested by the FS, the FERC would include an analysis of cultural attachment in the DEIS for the crossing of the Jefferson National Forest.

The next cooperating agencies conference call is scheduled for July 7, 2015.
