Meeting Summary

Today was the first pre-filing bi-weekly conference call. These calls will continue with participation by Mountain Valley Pipeline LLC (MVP) until they file an application for the Project with the FERC. At that point, MVP will drop off of the calls.

The FERC provided an overview of milestones to-date and a list of agencies that have agreed to be cooperating agencies.

The FERC was given comment letters, during its scoping meetings, pertaining to the United States Forest Service (FS)'s temporary use permit for surveys across the Jefferson National Forest. The FERC will scan these documents and add them to e-library.

MVP has filed all of the draft Resource Reports (RRs). The FERC will prepare data requests and questions on these RRs. FERC requested all comments/questions from cooperating agencies be emailed to Paul Friedman by the end of June.

It is MVP's current intent to provide only one set of draft RRs during pre-filing. MVP would revise the draft RRs based on FERC and cooperating agency comments, as well as in response to all relevant public scoping comments placed into the docket, and provide them as part its application to the FERC.

The next cooperating agencies conference call is scheduled for June 9.
